NOTES

- **3000/4000 Course Eligibility** – Students must have 60 earned credit hours *and* meet the course prerequisites listed in the below table with a minimum grade of C. Prior to earning 60 credit hours, students may enroll in upper level business courses through the “42 hour rule”.
- **42 HOUR RULE** – Business students will be eligible to take 3000/4000 level courses before they have 60 earned hours if they have:
 1. completed Area F effective Fall 2019 (ACCT 2101 & 2102; BUSA 1103, 2105 & 2106; and ECON 2106) or Area F prior to Fall 2019 (ACCT 2101 & 2102; BUSA 2105 & 2106; and ECON 2105 & 2106)
 2. *and* have a minimum of 42 earned hours. Students must also meet the course prerequisites listed below
This requires a manual override by COBA Student Services.
- Summer course offerings are not guaranteed.
